This year, 270 kids and teen volunteers, 30 counselors and 60 adult volunteers made Good Deeds Day possible. Our event also included 12 different projects executed in collaboration with, or to benefit, 11 different organizations throughout San Diego, resulting in 8900 items donated and 2000+ beneficiaries reached.
